### ORDINANCE NO. 10

#### EVANGELINE TOWNSHIP VANDALISM ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to protect the health, safety and general welfare of persons and property within Evangeline Township by providing penalties for certain types of vandalism and property destruction and to repeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith.

THE TOWNSHIP OF EVANGELINE, CHARLEVOIX COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

### SECTION I. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Evangeline Township Vandalism Ordinance.

## SECTION II. REGULATION

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully and maliciously destroy, deface, damage or injure any public property or private property owned by another.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully and maliciously break down, injure, mar, or deface any fence belonging to or enclosing lands not his own or to willfully and maliciously throw down or open any gate, bars, or fence, and leave the same down or open.
- C. The registered owner of any vehicle who knowingly permits the operator of or passenger in the same to use such vehicle for the purpose of violating any of the provisions of the within Ordinance shall be deemed to be aiding, assisting or abetting such violation and shall acordingly be in violation of the within Ordinance. The "registered owner" herein referred to shall be that person, firm or corporation in whose name the license plates upon the vehicle are registered.

# SECTION III. PENALTY

Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by the imprisonment in the county jail for not to exceed ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each act of vandalism shall constitute a separate offense.

### SECTION IV. VALIDITY

The several provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be

separate; if any Court of Law shall hold that any section or provision thereof is invalid, such holding shall not affect or impair the validity of any other section or provision of this Ordinance.

### SECTION V. REPEAL

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

# SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect on June 21, 1974.
