THE TOWNSHIP OF Evangeline ORDAINS,

The Township of Evangeline, County of Charlevoix, Michigan, ordains:

An Ordinance to control the sale of cemetery lots in the Evangeline Township Cemetery, Charlevoix County, Michigan.

Section 1

Any person who is, or has been, a resident or land owner of Evangeline Township, or has a relative already buried in the Evangeline Township Cemetery, Charlevoix County, Michigan, shall not be refused the right to purchase a lot, or parcel thereof, in the Evangeline Township Cemetery for the purpose of interment of a deceased person, providing the deceased person could have qualified as a purchaser when alive.

Section 2

Any deceased person who could have qualified as a purchaser under one or more of the requirements (in Section 1) and who has been deemed a pauper shall be entitled to one (1) grave-site.

Section 3

If the lawful owner of any vacant lot, or parcel thereof, wishes to dispose of same, he shall do so by selling the property back to Evangeline Township for an amount at the current selling price. The lawful owner must submit in writing to the Township Clerk his intention to sell, before any action can be taken.

Section 4

This Ordinance shall go into effect 20 days after its adoption.

This Ordinance was adopted by the Township Board at a Regular Board Meeting on February 14, 1972, and shall go into effect March 5, 1972.
